Sr. Dorothy Kazel was an Ursuline Sister who was martyred serving the people of El Salvador. She gave the ultimate sacrifice: her life. Though not nearly as profound as Sr. Dorothy's sacrifice, attending a Catholic High School is a privilege and requires sacrifice on the part of the student and the parent (guardian) who is paying the tuition.

Any eighth grader who is a registered, active parishioner of Ss. Robert & William Catholic Parish may apply for the \$500 Sr. Dorothy Kazel Scholarship. An essay describing what the word "Sacrifice" means is also required. Scholarship winners will be notified in late January and the money will be sent directly to the winner's high school to help defray the cost of Freshman year tuition.
